With remarkable distinction, our students have redefined the legacy of SH Kilimala, achieving impressive results in the 2025 Grade X and XII Board examinations. In grade XII, 26 of our students secured A1 grade in all subjects while 31 students secured 90% and above.

Mithra M.Kishor became the school topper with 99.4% in Commerce batch.

Rahul Mahadev was the topper in the Science Batch with 96 %.

100% result was consecutively secured for 17 years in Grade XII.

In Grade X, Joel James 98.8% secured A1 in all subjects and became the school topper with 98%. He also secured 100/100 in Social Science and Malayalam. 13 students secured A1 in all subjects and 24 students secured 90% above. We are indeed proud that our student Timothy Philip became the JEE Main 2025 B Planning Kerala Topper. Many students bagged top ranks in JEE Main and NEET this year too.
